

## **NCIET—2014**

## **Conference Report**

A one days National Conference on Innovative & Emerging Technologies, NCIET-2014 was organized 3<sup>rd</sup> January, 2014 in the campus by Smt. S. R. Patel Engineering College, Dabhi - Unjha.

Different technical research papers were invited under four different tracks of Civil Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Computer Engineering/ Information Technology and Electronics & Communication Engineering. The primary goal of the conference was to bring together the nationwide leading

All the key-note speakers, session chairs and jury members were associated with various NITs in and outside Gujarat, Government engineering colleges, well known engineering colleges and Universities.
