

They have to prepare working modal on the real world problems and take part in the global annual competition. The objective of the lab is to provide hands on learning to engineering students who have limited access to labs and mentors. The goal is to create the next generation of (Embedded systems) engineers in India with a practical outlook to take on challenging problems and provide solutions. The winner of the competition will be eligible for summer internship at IIT Bombay through e-Yantra Summer Internship program.

Electric Solar Vehicle Research Lab

We established Electric Solar Vehicle Lab to raise awareness among future generation of engineers about renewable energy resources and push them for development in this sector. The institute participates to design and manufacture their vehicles which are ergonomically sound, dynamically stable, light in weight and solar powered, and along with all these they have fun to drive at the same time. The institute provides the opportunity to represent vehicle made by students at international level along with more than 200 industries so that they can represent their vehicle to many multinational companies & ministries for Start Up Fund and Research Project.

Language Lab.






